COMMITTEES

Advocacy and Service

- Recommend action in accordance with the Objects of Zonta International and Zonta International's Biennial Goals to empower women through international and local service projects.
- Inform the membership of the biennial international projects and programs and their progress during the biennium.
- Propose service activities to the Club Board for recommendation to the membership.
- Advocate to influence laws and attitudes that effect women with the goal of assisting women to develop their full potential.
- Organize and conduct advocacy activities focusing on recognizing women's rights as human rights and on preventing violence against women.
- Collaborate with other like-minded organizations to educate the community about legal, political, economic, educational, health and professional issues which affect the lives of women and girls.

Membership and Outreach/Communication

- The primary goal is to recruit new members. This can be achieved through planned programs and/or providing a presence at Club and community events, including informational tables.
- Advance the Club so that it is better known in the community by:
 - Maintaining the Club's social media presence;
 - Promoting the Club's activities through various media outlets;
 - Announcing the Club's events; and
 - Educating about Zonta's mission, vision and goals.

Finance/Fundraising

- The primary goal is to raise funds throughout the year to help assist the Club with financial obligations to Zonta International and to provide funding for Club

projects/programs, promote Zonta's mission, support community and charitable causes and for high school scholarships.

- Organize the annual Women Making a Difference dinner or plan another main fundraising event each year of the biennium.

Special Events and Scholarship

- Plan, organize and implement the scholarship application process, selection of candidates and award ceremony.
- Organize the annual Amelia Earhart (AE) dinner in collaboration with the Zonta Club of Chelsea during January (AE month). This year (2025), Malden is the host Club. The event celebrates the spirit of the famous aviatrix for her contributions to aerospace and the empowerment of women. The event also recognizes the AE fellowships awarded by Zonta International in honor of Earhart's legacy.
